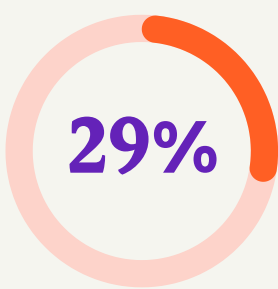

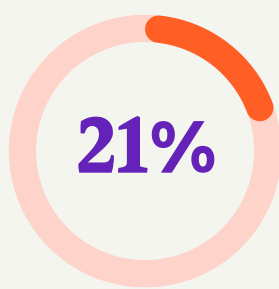


Physical Neglect

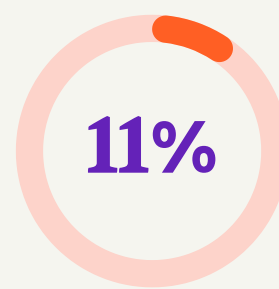

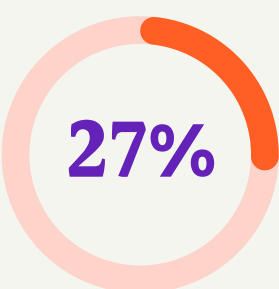

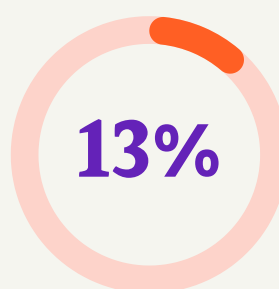

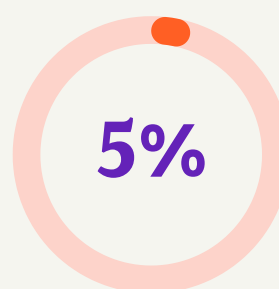

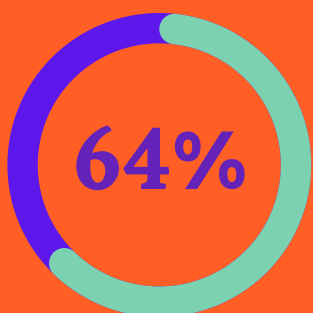
